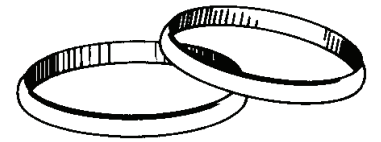


Join us for lunch with all the trimmings.

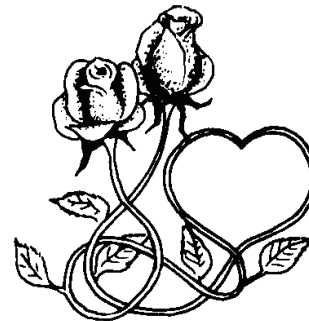

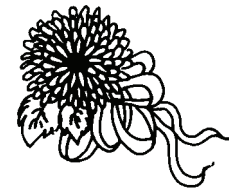
