Return completed form and payment to Lisa Rittmeyer or place it in the collection plate. Your poinsettias may be taken home after the worship service on December 20th.

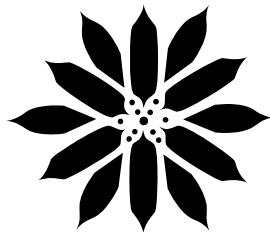
