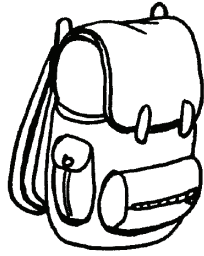


Carpenters Place needs your help!

Items you can donate for the back packs:

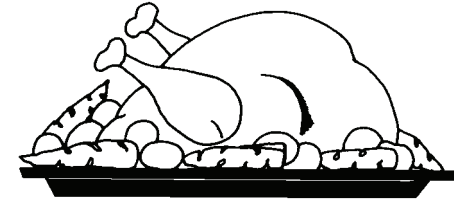
Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, disposable razors, shaving cream, lotion.

Dinner includes: Turkey & dressing, potatoes & gravy, veggie, salad, pie and beverage.

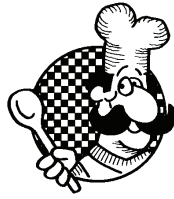
Donations of crafts, baked goods and candy will be gratefully accepted. Please plan ahead and prepare some items for this fund raiser.
